In accordance with the orders of the Commandant General Home Guards, Odisha, Cuttack vide letter number 233/HGs dtd. 05.02.2025 applications in the prescribed format (Form "A") were invited from the eligible candidates of Mayurbhanj District to fill up the 175 vacant (One hundred seventy five) posts of the Home Guards Volunteers.

Consequent upon the further instruction communicated vide Office Order No-1429/HGs dtd.17.04.2025 of Directorate of Home Guards, Odisha, Cuttack it is for the information of all that the Govt. of Odisha have been pleased to sanction 105 new (one hundred five) new posts of Home Guards volunteers to Mayurbhanj District.

On account of increase in strength by 105 (One hundred five) new posts of Home Guards Volunteers, applications in Form "A" are again invited from the eligible candidates of Mayurbhanj District. Those who have applied earlier in accordance with this district Advertisement No-108/Home Guards, Dtd. 03.03.2025 need not apply further, as their applications are already in account.

Application forms will be made available in all the Police Stations, and the Office of the Commandant, Home Guards, Mayurbhanj from 16.06.2025 Duly filled in applications should reach the office of "The Commandant Home Guards, office Mayurbhanj". The date of the selection test and the venue will be intimated in due course. The candidates should stay tuned with concerned PS/OP/Commandant Home Guards, Mayurbhanj to clear up the doubts regarding selection test and the venue.

- 2) After completing the form you should post or deliver it to the Commandant, Home Guards of the District. You will receive intimation in due course, whether your services can be utilised.
- 3) In requesting the employer or the superior officer to issue certificate mentioned in (1) above it may be pointed out that emergencies such as those that are referred to in paragraph (1) are not likely to arise very often. Prospective Home Guards should therefore not be scared away nor their employees or superior officers hesitate to issue the above certificate for just this reason.
