- (iii) They must have registration certificate / provisional certificate issued from West Bengal Nursing Council
- (iv) Upto 40 years of age as on 1st April of the year of publication of notice. Age relaxation as per Government norms (v) Proficiency in Bengali/local language & dialect.
- 2. Desirable criteria: Competency in MS Office & Internet.
- 3. Number of vacancy: Mention above.
- 4. The CHOs will be posted in any SC- Su swasthya Kendra.
- 5. Mode of selection: The candidates will be selected through merit list based on written test (85%) and interview (15%). The posting will be given after online counselling. The panel list will be valid for one year from the date of approval of panel.

- 5. Experience will be calculated after obtaining the required essential academic qualification for the above mentioned position, till the first date of online application.
- 6. Caste Certificate issued on or before the first date of online application, by the competent authorities of West Bengal only will be accepted. In case of OBC candidates Category 'A' must be mentioned specifically in the caste certificate. Otherwise the caste certificate will not be accepted.
- 7. The disability Certificate must be issued before the first date of online application by the competent authorities.
