# Notification for Engagement of Trade/Technician/Graduate Apprentice under the Apprentices Act, 1961 at IOCL (Marketing Division)-Northern Region

IndianOil Corporation Limited, one of the largest commercial undertaking in India and a Fortune "Global 500" Company, as a measure of Skill Building Initiative for the Nation, proposes to engage Technician, Graduate and Trade Apprentice (Technical and Non – Technical) at its Locations in States and UTs of India (Delhi, Haryana, Punjab, Chandigarh, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand).

Applications are invited from candidates meeting the following qualification & other parameters for engagement of Apprentices under Apprentices Act, 1961/1973/1992 (& as amended from time to time) in the Disciplines mentioned below:

\*\*NOTE: The reservation for PwBD as indicated for the Discipline of Graduate Apprentice, Trade Apprentice Data Entry Operator (Fresher & Skill Certificate Holders) shall be applied on horizontal basis, across all categories, as per the Government guidelines. PwBD are not eligible to apply for Discipline Code 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111. A person with specified disability listed in the Schedule appended to the Act but not covered under Section 34(1), if certified by the certifying Officer as a person with disability of 40% or above, shall be allowed concession/relaxation available to PwBD. His/her candidature will not be considered/adjusted against reservation provided to PwBDs under Section 34(1) of the Act of 2016.

For PwBD (Persons with Benchmark Disability) category, Govt. of India Guidelines shall apply.

The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 - Section 2(r) defines "person with benchmark disability" as a person duly certified by the certifying authority with

- not less than 40% of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and
- a disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms.

The candidates are required to submit a Disability Certificate issued by competent authority as per the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 failing which their candidature as PwBD candidates will not be considered.

Persons with Benchmark Disabilities must be capable of performing the task assigned to them/take instructions using suitable aids and appliances. Engagement of apprentices belonging to PwBD category will be from categories below:

1. PV-Low Vision, Blind P=Physical; V=Vision; H=Hearing;

2. PH-Hard of hearing, Deaf

L=Locomotors;

3. PL-Musculoskeletal (OH-OA/OL), Dwarfism,

OH=Orthopaedic Handicap;

Acid attack victim, Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy cured

OA=One Arm;

OL=One Leg

4. MD-Multiple Disabilities (a combination of above)

Deployment of PwBD with other disabilities, may put such PwBDs at risk, considering ours being a hazardous industry, hence not included.

STIPEND: Rate of stipend payable to apprentices per month shall be as prescribed under Apprentices Act, 1961/1973, Apprentices Rules 1992/2019 as amended from time to time. Over and above the statutory stipend, an additional amount of ₹ 2500/- shall be paid to the Apprentices as Miscellaneous expenses.

Part of the Graduate and Technician apprentice stipend is disbursed by Board of Apprenticeship Training (BOAT) directly in their bank accounts under the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) scheme. Rs 4500 for Graduate Apprentice and Rs 4000 for Technician Apprentice will be paid by the Board of Apprenticeship Training (BOAT) directly in their bank accounts and the remaining amount by Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. The cost of stipend borne by the Central Government shall be restricted to the first-time training only.

It is essential that the candidates have an Aadhaar seeded bank account that is enabled for Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) for receiving the Government's share of stipend from BOAT as well as their account details are correctly updated on NATS portal.

Trade Apprentice would be receiving the stipend in full, from Indian Oil Corporation Limited.

However, the above shall be subject to change as per guidelines and advice from Government/ Board of Apprenticeship Training/ National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) or any such body stipulated by the Act/ Rules for issuing guidelines regarding Apprenticeship, from time to time.

#### Prescribed Qualification/Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. **For Discipline Code –107** -Trade Apprentice (Fitter) –Matric with regular full time 2 (Two) year ITI (Fitter) course recognized by NCVT/SCVT. For ITI qualification in the relevant trade, eligibility shall be pass marks.
- 2. **For Discipline Code 108** Trade Apprentice (Electrician) Matric with regular full time 2 (Two) year ITI (Electrician) course recognized by NCVT/SCVT. For ITI qualification in the relevant trade, eligibility shall be pass marks.
- 3. **For Discipline Code 109**-Trade Apprentice (Electronics Mechanic) Matric with regular full time 2(Two) year ITI (Electronics Mechanic) course recognized by NCVT/SCVT. For ITI qualification in the relevant trade, eligibility shall be pass marks.
- 4. **For Discipline Code 110-** Trade Apprentice (Instrument Mechanic) Matric with regular full time 2(Two) year ITI (Instrument Mechanic) course recognized by NCVT/SCVT. For ITI qualification in the relevant trade, eligibility shall be pass marks.
- 5. **For Discipline Code 111-** Trade Apprentice (Machinist) Matric with regular full time 2(Two) year ITI (Machinist) course recognized by NCVT/SCVT. For ITI qualification in the relevant trade, eligibility shall be pass marks.
- 6. **For Discipline Code 101** –Technician Apprentice (Mechanical) –3 years regular full time Diploma in Mechanical Engineering with minimum 50% marks in aggregate for General, EWS and OBC-NCL& 45% in case of SC/ST/PwBD candidates for reserved positions from a Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC.
- 7. **For Discipline Code** –102 –Technician Apprentice (Electrical) –3 years regular full time Diploma in Electrical Engineering with minimum 50% marks in aggregate for General, EWS and OBC-NCL& 45% in case of SC/ST/PwBD candidates for reserved positions from a Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC.
- 8. **For Discipline Code 103** Technician Apprentice (Instrumentation) –3 years regular full time Diploma in Instrumentation Engineering with minimum 50% marks in aggregate for General, EWS and OBC-NCL& 45% in case of SC/ST/PwBD candidates for reserved positions from a Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC.
- 9. **For Discipline Code -104—**Technician Apprentice (Civil) 3 years regular full time Diploma in Civil Engineering with minimum 50% marks in aggregate for General, EWS and OBC-NCL& 45% in case of SC/ST/PwBD candidates for reserved positions from a Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC.
- 10. **For Discipline Code 105** -Technician Apprentice (Electrical & Electronics) –3 years regular full time Diploma in Electrical & Electronics Engineering with minimum 50% marks in aggregate for General, EWS and OBC-NCL& 45% in case of SC/ST/PwBD candidates for reserved positions from a Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC.
- 11. **For Discipline Code 106** Technician Apprentice (Electronics) –3 years regular full time Diploma in Electronics Engineering with minimum 50% marks in aggregate for General, EWS and OBC-NCL& 45% in case of SC/ST/PwBD candidates for reserved positions from a Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC.
- 12. **For Discipline Code 112** –Graduate Apprentice (BBA/BA/B. Com/B.Sc.) Regular full time Graduate in any discipline with minimum 50% marks in aggregate for General, EWS and OBC-NCL& 45% in case of SC/ST/PwBD candidates for reserved positions from a Institute/University recognized by AICTE/UGC.
- 13. **For Discipline Code 113** Trade Apprentice-Data Entry Operator (Fresher) Class 12th (but below graduate)
- 14. **For Discipline Code 114** Trade Apprentice-Data Entry Operator (Skilled Certificate Holders) Class 12th (but below graduate). Additionally, candidates should possess Skill Certificate of 'Domestic Data Entry Operator' for training of less than one year issued by an awarding body recognized under National Skill Qualifications Framework or any other authority recognized by the Central Government.
- 15. For all discipline codes: The qualification prescribed shall be from a recognized University/Institute <u>as a full-time regular course in relevant disciplines</u>. Qualification acquired through Part-time / Correspondence / Distance Learning mode shall render the candidate NOT ELIGIBLE for the above notified disciplines.
- 16. Wherever CGPA/OGPA or Letter Grade is awarded in the Class XII//ITI/Degree /Diploma examinations, its equivalent aggregate percentage of marks must be indicated in the Online Application as per the norms adopted by Board/University/Institute. Candidates will have

to furnish certificate from the concerned University/Institute regarding the equivalent aggregate percentage of marks with reference to their CGPA/OGPA or Letter grade at the time of document verification failing which their candidature will not be considered.

- 17. Diploma under recognized Institute/University lateral entry scheme (Class XII/ITI) admitted in the second year of Diploma course shall also be considered eligible subject to meeting prescribed percentage of marks based on aggregate of all semesters in the diploma course.
  - 18. A candidate who has already undergone one apprenticeship training is eligible to apply for a second apprenticeship training, provided that the second apprenticeship is in a different trade from the first. Further, there shall be a minimum gap of one year between the completion of the first apprenticeship training and commencement of the second apprenticeship training.

No gap shall be required in the case of termination of previous apprenticeship training due to failure on the part of the employer. Where an apprentice has terminated a previous apprenticeship contract due to health or financial hardship or relocation, transportation or career changes or language barrier, the waiting period of three month shall apply before the apprentice shall enter into another contract of apprenticeship with the same employer or any other employer and there shall be no waiting period for women.

Where the contract of apprenticeship is terminated for the failure on the part of the apprentice to carry out the terms of contract, the apprentice shall not be entitled to enter into another contract of Apprenticeship.

- 19. Candidates applying under NATS who have completed five years as on 31.12.2025 in relevant discipline after acquiring the prescribed qualification as per the last semester/ year marksheet shall NOT BE ELIGIBLE for engagement as apprentices.
- 20. Candidates applying under NAPS who have completed five years as on 31.12.2025 in relevant discipline after acquiring the prescribed qualification as per the last semester/ year marksheet shall NOT BE ELIGIBLE for engagement as apprentices.
- 21. In case the date of Declaration of result is not mentioned in the Mark Sheet, the candidate must submit a certificate mentioning the date of publication of result from the Principal of the Polytechnic/College/Institute from where the candidate pursued his course along with his Application Form.
- 22. Candidates registered with Local/State Employment Exchange(s)/ Vocational Rehabilitation Center for Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD)and meeting the prescribed eligibility criteria, are required to apply only through NAPS/ NATS portal, <u>failing which their candidature will not be considered</u>.
- 23. Candidates possessing higher professional qualifications such as **B.E or equivalent**, **MBA or equivalent or MCA / CA/ ICWA**, **LLB or any such equivalent or pursuing higher qualification and having completed the same on or before joining the apprenticeship training shall NOT** be considered eligible. A declaration from the candidate in this regard shall be obtained at the time of joining. Suppression of information regarding possession or pursuing higher qualification shall render a candidate ineligible for consideration at any stage of selection/termination or any time during period of training.
- 24. Diploma Holder or Vocational Certificate holder Candidates having job experience for a period of one year or more after the attainment of the qualification shall not be eligible to be engaged as Apprentice.
- **B.** Age: Minimum 18 years and maximum 24 years as on 31.12.2025 (Relaxation of 5 years for SC/ST i.e. up to a max of 29 yrs., 3 years for OBC-NCL i.e. up to a max of 27 yrs., for the posts reserved for them). Candidates belonging to PwBD categories shall be given age relaxation up to 10 years (up to 15 years for SC/ST and up to 13 years for OBC-NCL candidates).
- C. Period of Apprenticeship Training: 12 Months

#### D. Selection Methodology:

- 1. Candidates registered on NAPS/NATS portal, and applying against the notification shall be considered for selection. There will be no written Test/Interview.
- 2. Merit list of all the candidates who have applied against a respective post in the portal and meeting the eligibility criteria shall be prepared based on the percentage of marks secured in the prescribed qualification for the post. In case of two candidates securing same percentage of marks, the candidate with earlier date of birth (older in age) shall be considered. In case of same date of birth, candidates having a higher percentage marks in matriculation shall be considered.
- 3. Preference shall be accorded to candidates applying for Apprenticeship training for the first time.
- 4. The shortlisted candidates will be called for document verification and will have to complete Pre-engagement medical fitness test for being adjudged suitable for engagement.
- 5. Candidates are advised to ensure that they are medically fit as per Indian Oil's pre-engagement medical standard. Candidates are advised to go through the "Guidelines and Criteria for physical Fitness for Pre-Engagement Medical Examination" before they commence the application process. 6. Candidates successfully qualifying document verification and Pre-engagement medical fitness shall be adjudged suitable for engagement and shall be issued offer of Engagement for Apprenticeship Training. An amount of a maximum up to ₹ 3000/- shall be reimbursed to the candidate towards expenses incurred for conducting tests/investigations during pre-engagement medical, on production of receipt for the same.

#### E. Concessions /Relaxation:

1. SC/ST/OBC (NCL-Non Creamy Layer) candidates applying for Unreserved (UR) seats shall be considered subject to their fulfilling the standards applicable to candidates belonging to General category.

- 12. The decision of the Management will be final and binding on all candidates on all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, mode of selection, cancellation of the selection process either in part or full, etc. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard. Filling up of the seats is solely at the discretion of the management based on suitability of candidates and no claim will arise for engagement, if some of these seats are not filled due to unsuitability/insufficient number of candidates.
- 13. Applications/Registration which are incomplete or are received in any other mode/form, or not fulfilling the eligibility criteria and/or those received after the last date of applying shall not be considered "Eligible" and treated as "Rejected". Canvassing of any kind shall disqualify the candidate.
- 14. The period of Apprenticeship Training is 12 months for all disciplines. Upon completion of the apprenticeship period, the Corporation shall have NO obligation to offer regular employment to such apprentices NOR can an Apprentice claim right for employment on the grounds of completion of Apprenticeship. All ex-apprentices will have an equal opportunity along with other candidates to appear against the notified opportunities as per the laid down criteria and the competitive process for recruitment of non-executives in the Corporation.
- G. Requirement before applying:
