INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES CALLED FOR COUNSELLING/ ADMISSION TO All UG, Integrated PG and PG COURSES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-25.

General Instruction

1. The candidates should report **IN PERSON** on the date of admission mentioned in the call letter. Proxy or substitutes will not be permitted under any circumstances.
2. If the admission is offered against the verification of the certificates and other related documents, the candidate should complete the admission formalities on the same day. Extension of time will not be permitted for any reason/s. The Candidate and the parent have to submit **anti-ragging** declaration duly signed at the time of admission.
3. The candidates have to download and fill the forms as mentioned in the checklist and submit the same **(One set of Photocopies with Original documents)** at the time of admission.
4. After confirmation of the admission in the respective programme, the candidates are required to pay the Prescribed Fees through online at the payment gateway displayed at the University.
5. During the admission process or later, if any of the documents submitted by the candidate is found to be false, University is having all the rights to cancel the admission at any time without any information.
6. Candidates should submit the proof of result of the qualifying examination and other related documents at the time of admission without fail.
7. In case of non-submission of Transfer and Migration Certificates, and the qualifying exam certificates, candidates may be allowed up to 15 days to submit the same failing which such admissions will also be cancelled without any notice.
8. Once the candidates are admitted in any programme are not allowed to pursue any other offline programme/s or taking of any job during the period of their study. Already those who are employed, if selected they have to obtain necessary leave on lien, for the duration of the course and furnish a copy of the lien order, relieving order, conduct certificate and 'NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE' from their employers.

Instructions for OBC. SC. ST and PwD Candidates

1. OBC (non-creamy layer) candidates should submit the latest certificate in the prescribed format in support of their claim issued by a Competent Authority. Candidates are required to submit the OBC certificate in the prescribed Govt. of India Format.
2. Candidates selected under PwD category have to submit the Disability Certificate at the time of admission failing which his/her candidature under PwD category will not be considered.

Instructions for Economically Weaker Section

The candidates who are seeking admission under EWS quota are required to submit a certificate issued by:

1. District Magistrate / Additional district Magistrate / Collector / Deputy Commissioner / Additional Deputy commissioner / 1st class Stipendiary Magistrate / Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate / Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant commissioner.

2. Chief Presidency Magistrate / Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate / Presidency Magistrate.
3. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar or
4. Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and / or his family normally resides.

Note: *In all case of disputes and unforeseen/contingency circumstances, the decision of the University will be final. Any form of canvassing / malpractice will lead to disqualification / cancellation of candidature.*
